Necessary procedures after arriving in Sapporo [1] ~ [3]

[1] Procedures at the ward offices

- Submitting a "Address Change Notification" to the ward office to register your residence.
- Enrolling in National Health Insurance (mandatory to all who stay in Japan for over 3 months)
- Enrolling in National Pension System (mandatory to all the residents in Japan aged over 20 years old)



[2] Procedures at the post office

- Submitting a "Change of Address Notice" to the Post office to start your postal service.
- Payment of Student Insurance* (GAKKENSAI and FUTAIBAISEKI-Course A).



[3] Procedures at the bank

- Opening a bank account (MEXT: Required /Self-Supported: Optional)



Three types of Insurance for Students

It's mandatory for all HU students to purchase the following two insurances!

"GAKKENSAI/学研災 (PAS)" and "FUTAIBAISEKI-Course A/付帯賠償-コース A"

It's optional, but strongly recommended to have "Inbound Futai-Gakuso/インバウンド付帯学総".

Must be submitted to IAOE after processing.

Submission to IAOE ✖Required for all students

Samples of [1] ~ [3]

- [1] Passport (① Face photo page ② Permission of Landing page)
- [2] Residence Card (both sides) *Submit a copy after registering your address at the ward office.
- [3] Japan National Health Insurance Card *It will be post-mailed after enrollment.
- [4] Contact Information Sheet *Please submit the sheet to IAOE as soon as possible.

By JR line:

If you take Namboku line, get off at Kita juni jo Station, 4 minutes walk to North 13 Gate, or get off at Kita juhachi jo Station, 7 minutes walk to North 18 Gate.
